Course progress, visa condition and implications

Student visa condition 8202 – meet course requirements

- 8202 - Meet course requirements: The visa holder must satisfy the requirements of course enrolment, course level, course progress and course attendance.

GBCA monitoring process

"Course progress" is referring to:

- participating in scheduled classes course related information sessions, supervised study sessions and mandatory and supervised work-based training (if applicable) and
- satisfactory completing required assessment

“At risk of unsatisfactory progress” is defined by GBCA as not participating in at least 60% of scheduled classes, course related information sessions, supervised study sessions and mandatory and supervised work-based training (if applicable) during the first half of the study period.

“Unsatisfactory course progress” is:

- Not participated in at least 60% of scheduled classes, course related information sessions, supervised study sessions or
- and mandatory and supervised work-based training (if applicable), not successfully completed or demonstrated competence in at least 50% of the units in a study period.

GBCA monitoring process

- Every 5 weeks: students who are “at risk of unsatisfactory progress” will be sent a letter of advice. GBCA to offer educational supports to students
- At the end of each term (10 weeks), Warning letter will be sent to students who are “Unsatisfactory progress”. Student **MUST** attend intervention meeting. Intervention strategy will be arranged for student. Student must follow the arrangement to avoid further warning.
- If a student continuing “Unsatisfactory progress” for two consecutive study period: Notice of Intention to report - Unsatisfactory course progress. (visa condition 8202).
- Student have 20 working days to appeal: submit evidence as why GBCA **SHOULD NOT** report student.

Implication of being REPORTED based on unsatisfactory course progress (attendance for ELICOS)?

- (1) Breach student visa condition may lead to a cancellation of the current visa.
- (2) Future visa application: the applicant's record of compliance with any condition of a visa previously held.
- (3) Application form: declaration "have never breached... conditions" → false and misleading information
